**** FAQ ****

"What is the Cuccjs?"

The Carleton University Criminology & Criminal Justice Society, or "CUCCJS", is an organization, run by student volunteers and open to all with an interest in Criminology & Criminal Justice. Throughout the year, the CUCCJS offers members not only valuable academic & career oriented events, but also offers social events where students can meet new friends, relax and have fun enjoying the "university experience".

"So... How does this work?"

CUCCJS Members are advised via email of upcoming meetings and/or events as well as CCJI news, Carleton Events and Career and Volunteering Opportunities on campus & in the community. Member notices of this kind are sent out on a weekly basis during the Fall & Winter terms and periodically throughout the Summer.

"Do I have to be a Crim Major to join?"

You do NOT have to be a Criminology student to join! All you need is an interest in law, criminal justice or criminology in general.

"Can I join if I'm in 1st year?"

You do NOT have to be in a specific year to join! Undergrad, Grad students - full time, part time or just taking half a credit course out of interest - everyone is welcome!

"When can I join?"

Registration normally takes place in September however, you can register at any time throughout the year. Please note there are no adjustments made to membership fees due to late registration. (The 1 year membership runs from Sept 15th – Sept 14th).

"When are events held?"

Every effort is made to accommodate members' class schedules when planning events, however, we have traditionally been 200+ members strong and are limited by the availability of speakers, rooms & tour dates. Members will always be further advised well in advance.
